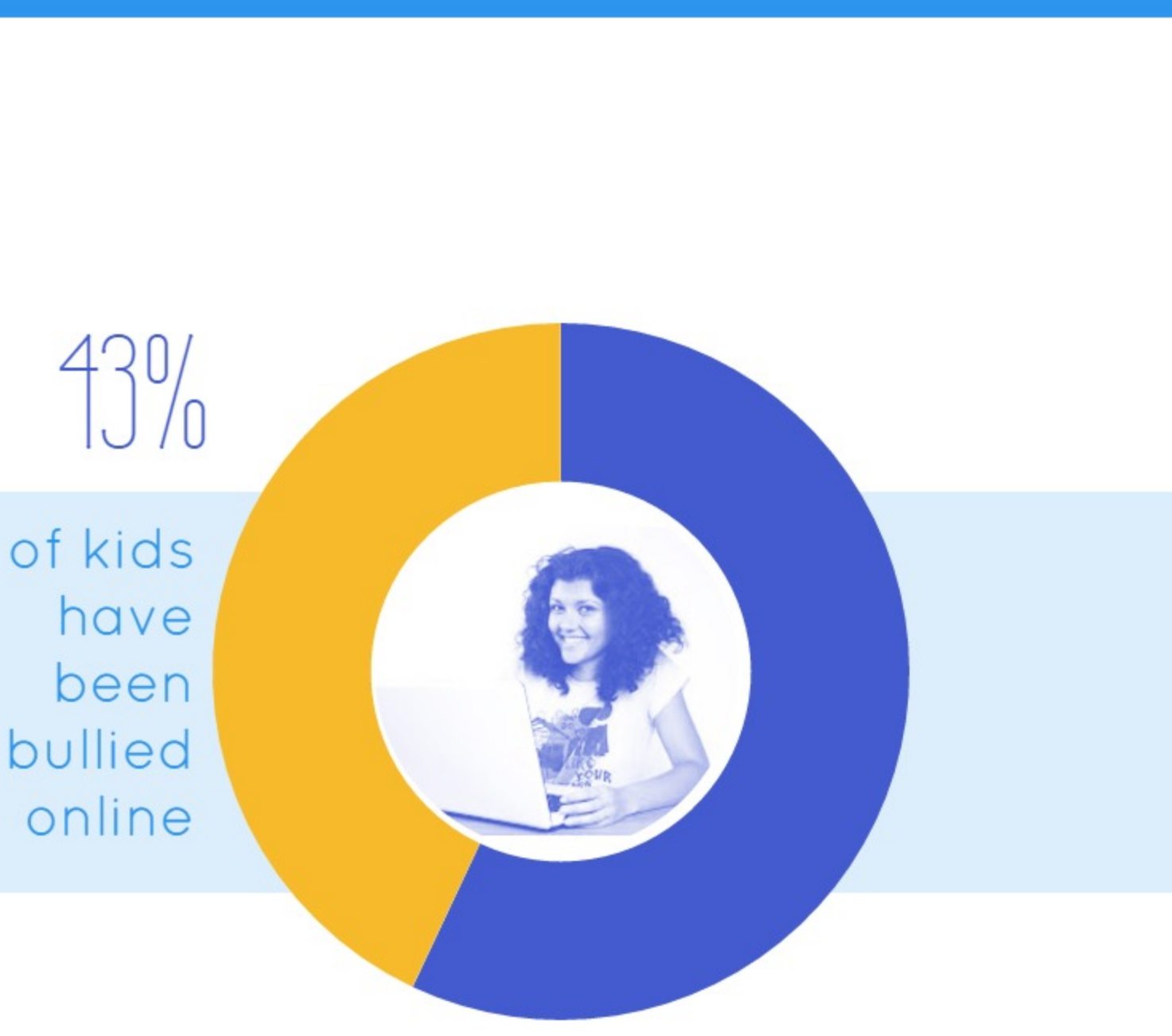


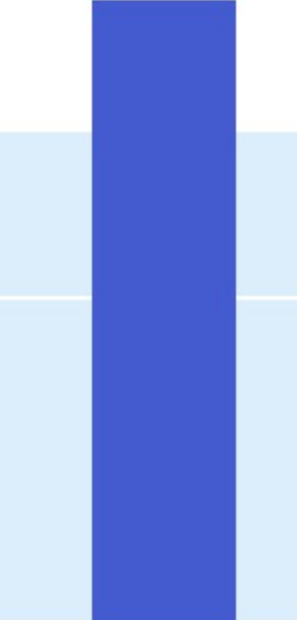

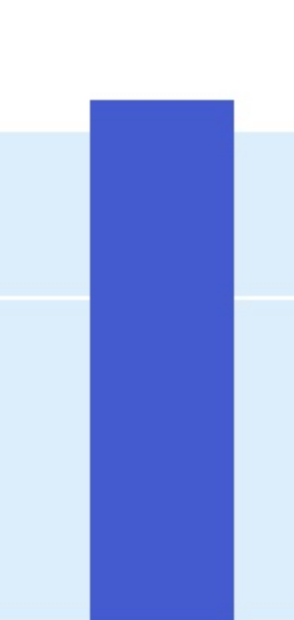
How often does cyber bullying occur?



Do teens have access to smartphones?

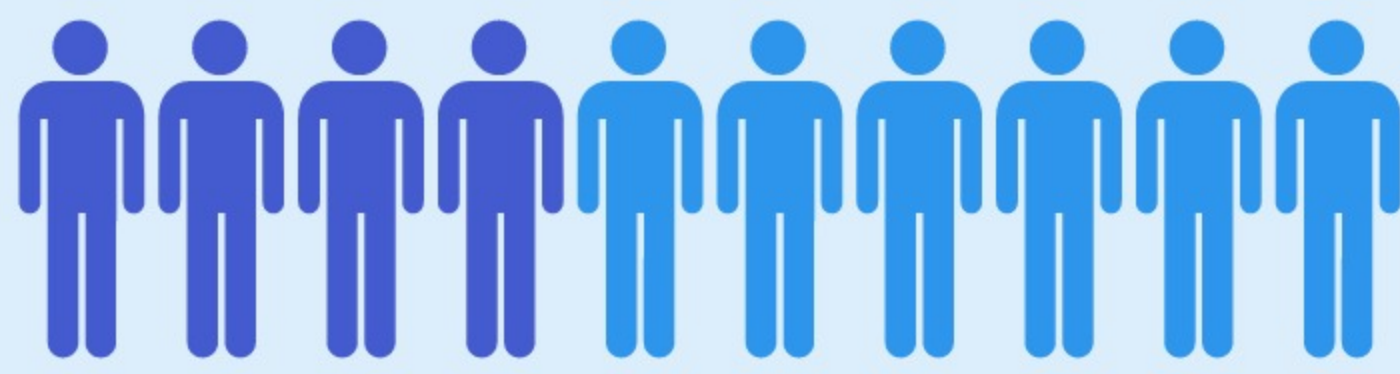


94% Own a smartphone

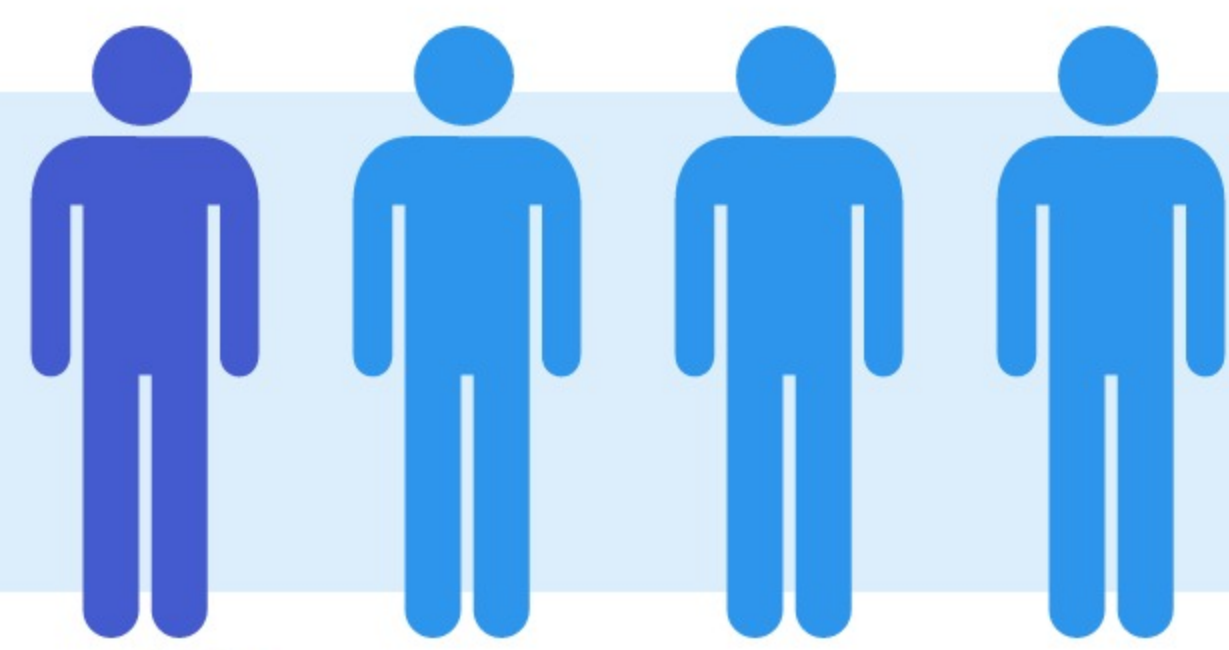


89% Own a laptop or tablet

Cyber Bullying: How much really happens?

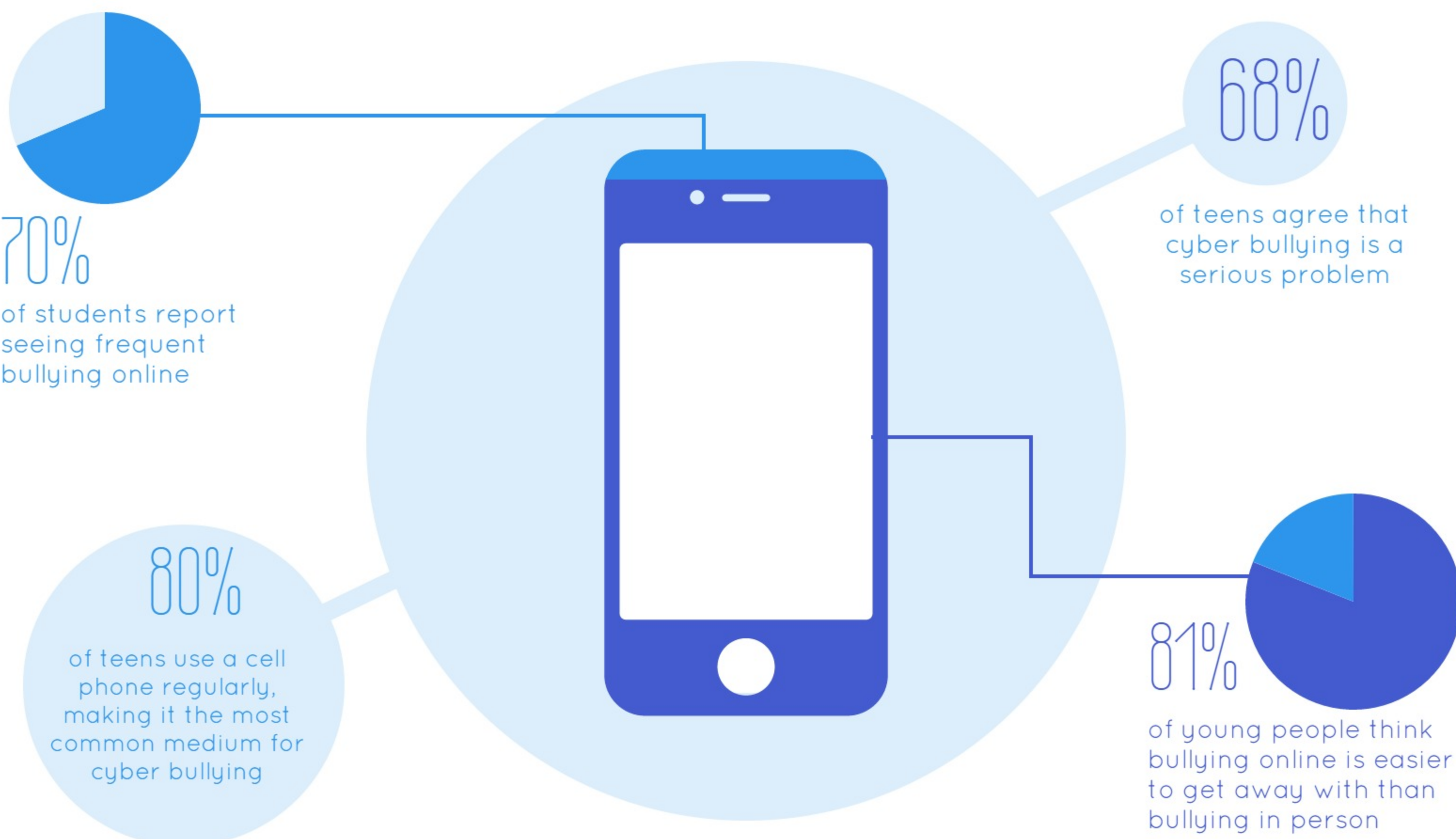


43% of kids have been bullied online

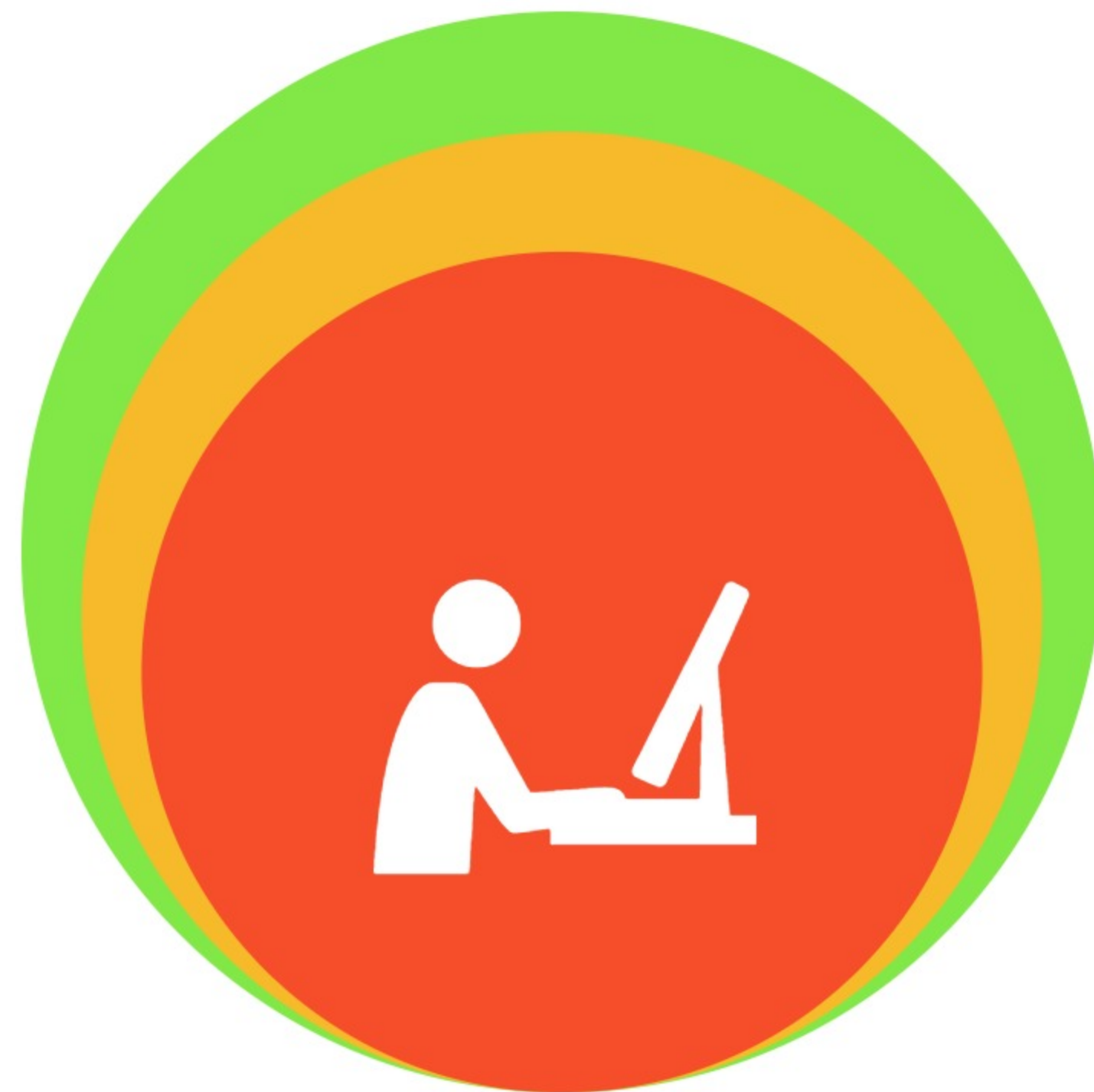


1 in 4 kids has been bullied more than once

What are teens doing about cyber bullying?



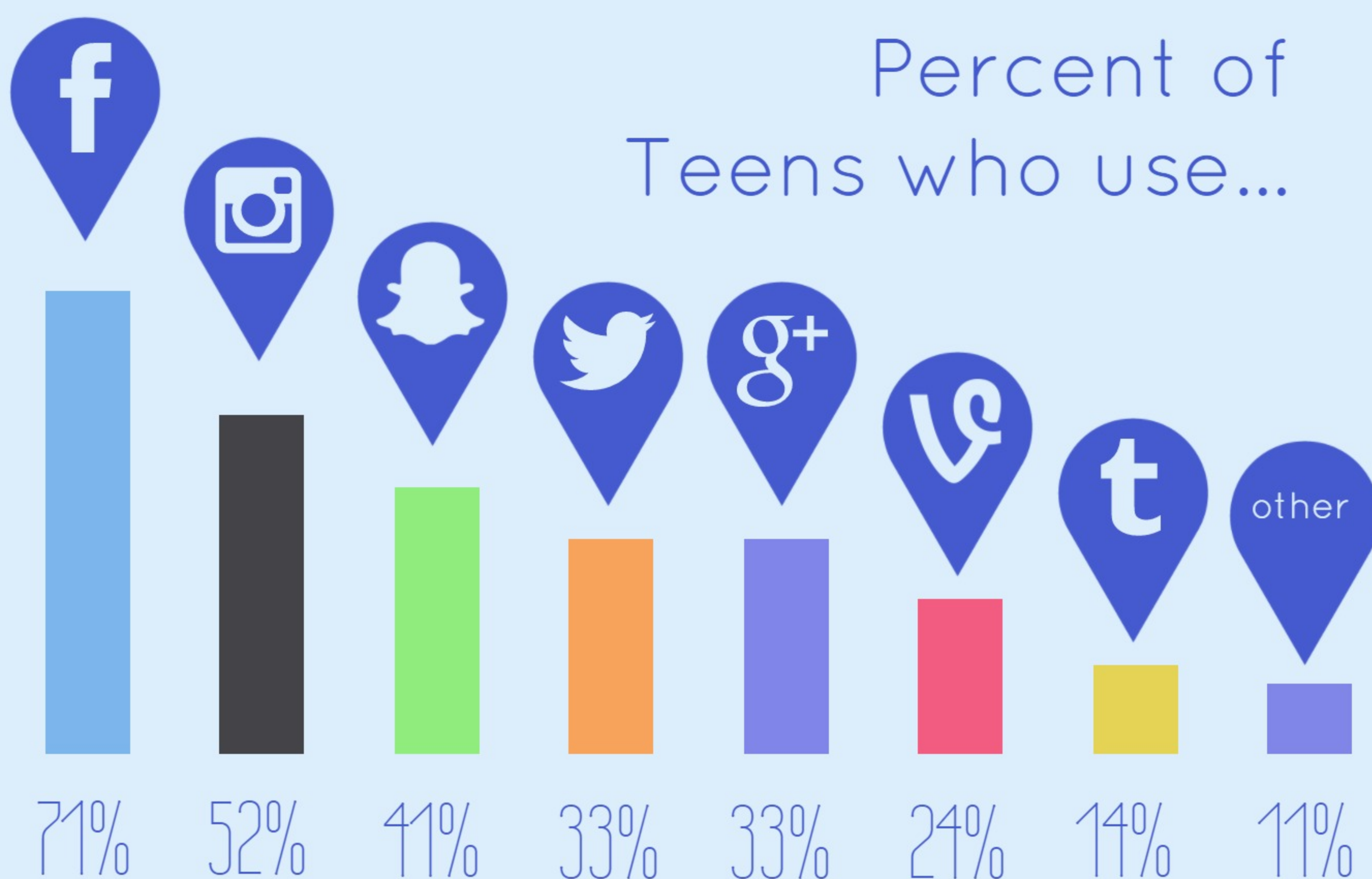
90% of teens who have seen social-media bullying and ignored it.

Percent of Teens who use...

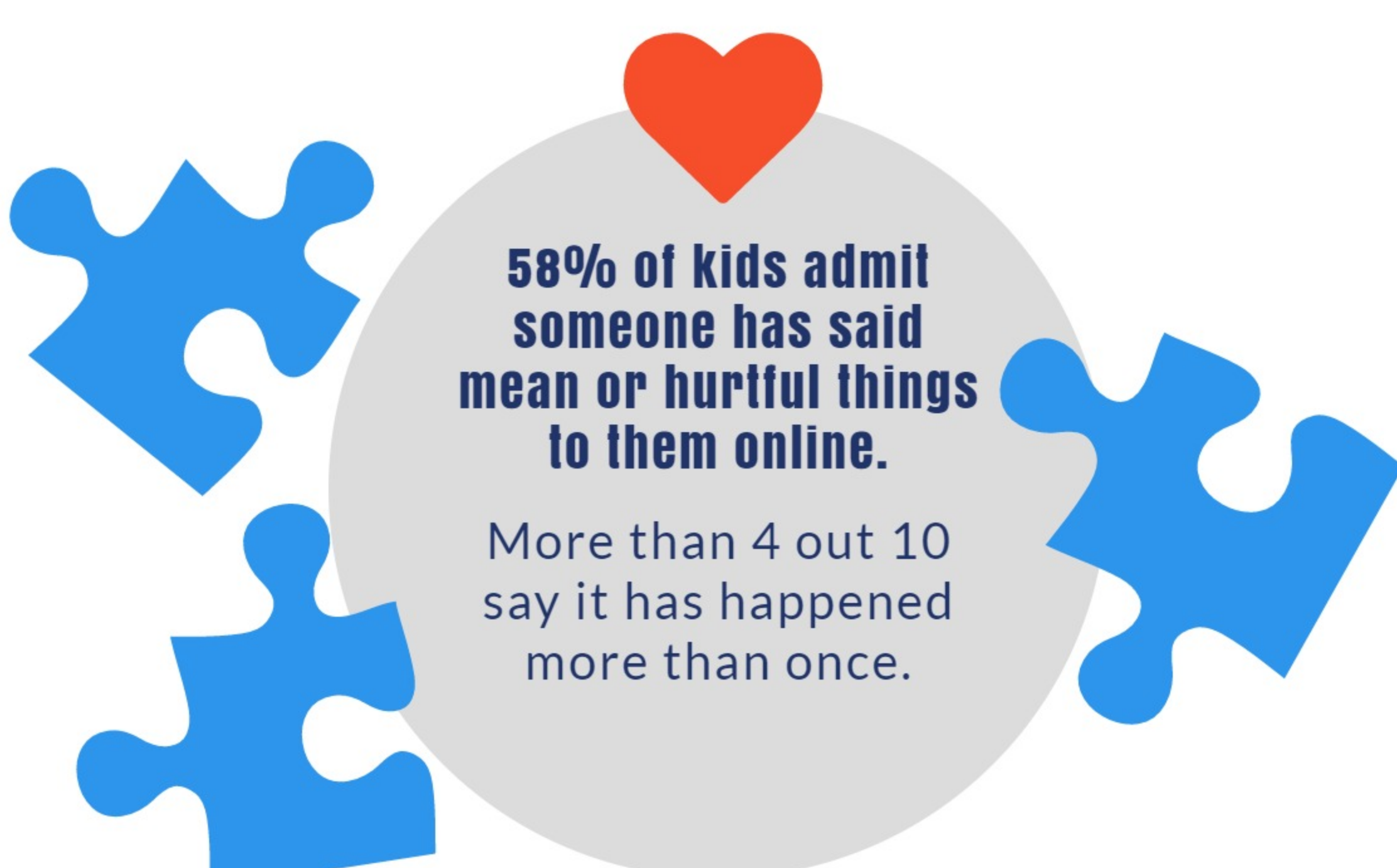


01 in 10 victims
